MR. W. FRANK M'GEE WILL **ERECT ANOTHER LARGE** STORE ROOM

#### INSTALL GRIST MILL

He Will Also Have Latest Model Will be Made of Asphalt Plant-Grist and Feed Mill Put in-Mr. Finley Also Building.

building, which will be a combination store and ware room, will be approximately 28 feet by 100 feet and will be connected to the present store room by large arches, practically doubling his plant and allowing ample room for his increasing business room for his increasing business which has outgrown his present large

The rear half of the new building will be used as a ware room to store heavy goods and reserve stock. The floor of the ware room will be wagon body high above grade, to make loading and unloading easy, the ware room being connected to the present store

being connected to the present store room by an incline for easy trucking. The front half of the new store will be fitted up in the most up to date manner, with tile floors and plate glass front, set in metal, with marble base below the glass and prismatis glass above the plate glass.

The front of the store room will be of pressed brick, the backs of the show windows will be glazed french doors and sides and overhead of show windows will be panelled with Beaver board.

Ample provision has been made for lighting and ventilation and every-thing that goes into the construction of the building will be of the best.

When finished the building will be one of the most modern and up to date in this section and will give Mr. McGee a magnificent plant for his

large and growing business.

The plans for the building were made by Casey and Fant, architects

of Anderson.

Mr. McGee has just had erected one arge warehouse in the rear of his present store room, and he stated yesterday that in this building he would install a grist mil and a feed mill. These will be put in at an early
