Charle Janvier, Vice-President of the Canal Louisiana Bank of New Orleans, made an address at the Farmers' Union meeting, during the morning session of the last day, that pertains particularly to what it is hoped will be gained by building a big storage warehouse for cotton at New Orleans, one of the livest subjects now before the Union. He aroused much applause, speaking as follows:

"Instead of being compelled to summarily sell your crop to bargain-hunters as rapidly as it reaches the market, you should be put in a position where you might be able to use some discretion and to dispose of your cotton at its natural value and not at artificial prices dictated and fixed by temporary, unfavorable conditions.

Instead of having your cotton swished from your field's and hurried across the sea into foreign warehouses, there to be held and distributed in the natural order of trade, you should be able, yourselves, to hold and distribute it from a market of your own, and yourselves receive the benefit which under present unnatural conditions accrue to others.

WHAT IS NEEDED.

"This consummation may be reached by providing a safe, inexpensive and convenient place in which may be housed that portion of your crop for which

the time it comes to market, there to be held until, through gradual and healthy assimilations, a temporary superabundance has been disposed of and normal conditions restored. That place will be a great central warehouse located in this great metropolis of the South. New Orleans will then become not only your convention city, but your market city.

WHY A GREAT CENTRAL WAREHOUSE.

"In my opinion, the first step in the effort to bring about these highly desirable conditions is the creation of facilities which shall afford the safe and adequate fireproof warehousing and economical handling of your cotton and the issuance therefor of warehouse receipts which shall be so safe and so secure, and generally known to be such, that any banker or money-lender in the financial world will not hesitate to accept them as gilt-edge security for loans made."
