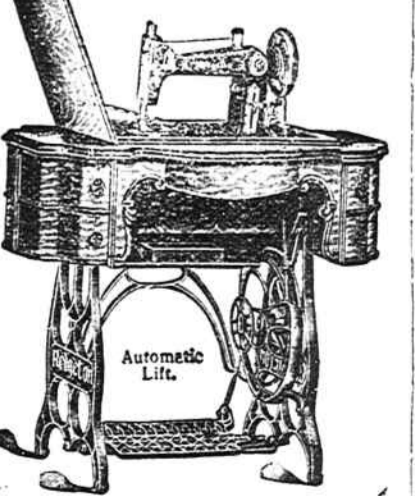

## American Women Siew.

American women seem slow in utilizing one of the greatest labor-saving devices ever invented for the householder. Several years ago fireless stoves or self-cookers came into use in Germany. They consist of boxes, constructed with doublewalls, containing material that prevents the escape of heat. The food is first thoroughly heated on an ordinary stove, then placed inside the box, sealed and left until wanted, when it is taken out, steaming hot, and with all the flavors retained that, by the ordinary process of cooking, are dissipated. American men promptly utilized this discovery; fireless stoves have been found invaluable by the army in the west. Why have the women remained apathetic? Is it because the self-cooker, as at first constructed, was available only for boiling or stewing food? If so, there is no further excuse for holding back, for, as Coastal General John W. Dye writes from Berlin, there is now on the market an improved fireless stove that not only cooks, but fries and roasts, with the aid of a heated stone. Here is a help in solving the servant problem by reducing the hours of work.

## "Africa for the Africans."

Dispatches from South Africa report the existence of great unrest among the natives and express an apprehension that another black rebellion against white government is imminent. The Philadelphia Enquirer, that this situation is largely the result of a propaganda conducted by persons of African descent, who went to Liberia from this side of the Atlantic, and thence scattered through the territories south of the Zambezi, preaching as they went the doctrine of "Africa for the Africans," urging the natives to cease quarreling among themselves in order to make common cause against the foreign enemy, and declaring it to be in the power of the natives, by a united effort, to drive the white invaders into the sea. This kind of talk is said to have made a deep impression on the always warlike Zulus and on the other tribes resident in Natal and in the British colonies formerly constituting the South African republic and the Orange Free State.
