The Lutheran Synod meets this week at Lexington.

Rock Hill is erecting a new city jail. It will contain 16 cells. Some fine hogs, were shown at Cherokee county's Live Stock show at Gaffney last week.

Divison Engineer Jones of the South & Western, writes the railroad commission that his road will be ready for final inspection and regular operation to Spartanburg in a few days.

W. M. Jordan, a Greenville contractor, has been awarded the contract for building a handsome new hotel in Fountain Inn. Work on this building will start soon. The cost of this hotel is said to be estimated at between \$20,000 and 30,000.

Coroner J. M. Stevens of Greenwood county, who was elected to his office in the primary of 1908 was found dead in his bed last Thursday morning. Heart failure is supposed to have been the cause of his death. Mr. Stevens had been troubled with heart disease for some time.

Logan Berry was struck by a Coast Line train at Newberry on Thursday and instantly killed. He and Joe Lawrence were walking down the track between Prosperity and Newberry when struck. Lawrence was knocked off, but not injured. Lawrence says Berry claimed to be from Greenville.

TO CONTEST ELECTION.
Defeated Candidate at Memphis Asks Re-count of Ballots.
Memphis, Tenn.—By a plurality of 79 votes over former Mayor J. J. Williams, his nearest opponent, Edward H. Crump won out on the face of the returns in the mayoralty election. The contest was the closest ever held in Memphis and nearly 18,000 votes were polled.
Mr. Williams refused to accept the returns as announced and said that he will file a petition with the county election commission, asking for a re-count of the ballots.

Murder Verdict Found by Jury.
Rome, Ga.—The jury find that Will Nelson came to his death from a gunshot wound inflicted by a person unknown to the jury. This was the verdict reached by the coroner's jury in the death of Will Nelson, who was shot near the camp of the Rome and Northern Railroad Construction corps, and lingered for a week before his death. Coroner Miller has been conducting a rigid investigation and it is believed certain now that he will apprehend the slayer.

The new division of the South Carolina Presbytery which was made by the synod at Charleston meeting, met at Greenwood Tuesday night and formally organized. The new presbytery will include Greenwood, Abbeville, Newberry, Saluda and a part of Lexington counties. The moderator who presided at Tuesday night's first meeting was Rev. T. P. Burgess. The new moderator is Rev. J. R. Hillhouse of Abbeville. The next meeting will be held at Morris chapel in Newberry county next April. The following trustees were elected: R. P. Blake of Greenwood, also the treasurer; F. B. Cobb of Greenwood, R. J. Nickels of Hodges, W. A. Stevenson of Abbeville and J. C. Thomas of Abbeville.

That rats disseminate disease is reason enough for a campaign against them, but the new Association Internationale pour la Destruction Rationnelle des Rats, a society originating in Copenhagen, made its first appeal to the thrifty Danes on economic grounds. In the capital and its environs the association's emissaries bagged more than a hundred thousand rats, at a cost, for capture and destruction, of about three cents each. "Now," argued the committee, "you will agree that each rat eats and destroys each day a half-cent's worth of food and material. One hundred thousand rats would do \$200,000 worth of damage, at least. Having spent about \$3,500 on killing them, we have saved you \$190,000." Both farmers and city folk were won by this demonstration, and now the government is abetting the association in its work of "rational destruction."
