### FOUND DEAD IN BED

**Mrs. Pauline Smith Probably Suicided by King Carbolic Acid. Jealous of Husband.**

The dead body of Mrs. Pauline Smith, aged 24, was found in her bed by her husband when he awoke yesterday morning at his home in Spartanburg. She had probably been dead all night.

The coroner's jury found that death resulted from an overdose of laudanum, administered by herself. Finger prints on the cheek of the dead woman aroused suspicion of foul play, but Dr. W. H. Chapman testified that her death could not have been caused by these. Dr. Chapman also testified that he detected a decided odor of carbolic acid in the cup from which the laudanum had been taken, but he covered no evidence of carbolic acid burns.

The general belief is that jealousy caused Mrs. Smith to take her life. It is known that her husband often jested with her about his devotion to other women, and she resented it. They had at one time been separated. On Monday afternoon Mrs. Smith purchased a small bottle of laudanum from a drug store near her home.

At the inquest Smith testified that both he and his wife worked in the mill. She usually awoke before he did. Yesterday morning when the whistle blew he was surprised that she did not speak. When he got a light he found her stiff in death. An empty cup and bottle labeled laudanum on the table beside the bed told the story.

### "Boozarina" at Spartanburg

If one is to judge from the amount of whiskey packages that are being handled at the Southern Express Company's "boozarina," there are thousands of thirsty people in Spartanburg county. Every express car arriving in the city brings in many jugs and bottles of liquid goods to quench the thirst of the perishing. The "boozarina" was opened in the Harris-Green building, near the express office, for the purpose of handling Christmas booze. Ever since the establishment was opened it has done a thriving business, for several clerks are kept busy waiting on those who sent in rush orders to whiskey houses for liquor.—Spartanburg Journal.

## GOLD MINE FOUND IN THIS COUNTY.

Vein One And A Half Miles Long And Eighty Feet Wide.  
LOCATED NEAR TABLE ROCK.

Experts Have been at Work.—Owned by Mr. John H. O'Neal.—Government Assayist Shows Value of \$23.15 in Gold Per Ton.

Last June, Mr. J. H. O'Neal, of this City invested in a farm or lands containing 250 acres, in the western part of the County, near Table Rock Mountain, and on account of the fine timbers there he considered the investment a splendid one. There are more than five thousand dollars worth of valuable timbers on the property, consisting of a large amount of hard wood timbers.

It has recently developed that besides a very fine growth of magnificent forest timbers the most valuable asset is the very rich vein of gold and silver ore that has been discovered. One vein has been found to be one and a quarter miles in length and eighty feet wide, which according to the investigation by the Government Assayist, shows \$23.15 in gold and \$1.18 in silver.

Several experts have recently made tests of this mine, and they are of the opinion that Mr. O'Neal has one of the richest gold fields in the country, this side of California.

Mr. O'Neal will, within the near future, make preparations to have this mine developed on a large scale, and he feels satisfied that there is a fortune.

Gold and other minerals have been discovered in large quantities not far from the O'Neal property; but Mr. O'Neal thinks he has found the main vein, and he will spare no expense in developing his property.—Greenville Daily Piedmont.

## CHANGE URGENT AT STATE ASYLUM

Senator Christensen Says Conditions Just Now are Shocking

Senator Neils Christensen, Jr., of Beaufort, chairman of the joint legislative committee appointed to investigate conditions in the State hospital for, the insane at Columbia was in Charleston today and was asked by a reporter for the Evening Post concerning the progress made by his committee in the investigation. Senator Christensen said that the investigation had been concluded and that the committee is now formulating a report for submission to the General Assembly which convenes on the eleventh of next month.

"The testimony taken before the committee," said Senator Christensen, "is being printed and will be available in a few days. Any member of the legislature and any newspaper interested may have a copy by sending a request to a member of the committee. The most important matter to be considered at the coming session of the Legislature is the report of their committee that has investigated the State hospital for the insane. Unfortunately, the report will not be ready for two or three weeks. It will contain several special reports by experts which are not yet prepared. These together with facts gathered by the committee from personal examination of physical condition and records here and elsewhere are perhaps more important than the testimony of witnesses referred to. But it would be advisable for legislators and the people generally to acquaint themselves with their testimony which throws a flood of light on the deplorable conditions that are general throughout our State hospital for the insane.

"It is going to take several hundred thousand dollars to put this institution in reasonably good condition. Estimates have not been made yet, but the total necessary is not likely to be under \$600,000. That is a minimum. There can be no doubt that if the facts become known this or a larger sum, if it be found necessary, will be voted. But there is danger that the facts will not become thoroughly understood in time for the people to make their wishes felt at this session. Up to this time the facts have been minimized by certain news agencies and in only a few instances have the newspapers given anything like a full and accurate account of the testimony. So, I want to suggest to the press generally that they get the testimony and read it for themselves.

"While it would be very unfortunate to allow such an investigation as this to become an attack on individuals, there will also be a lamentable outcome if a desire to shield individuals should result in covering up conditions. We are here dealing with matters of life and death. There is no question that the death rate at this institution is abnormally high and the recovery rate abnormally low owing to shocking unsanitary conditions, poor equipment, a lack of proper treatment and lax methods throughout all branches of the institution that are deplorable. It is painful to make these general criticisms, for there are many faithful workers at this hospital struggling with conditions that only their superiors can remedy and they are as anxious as any to see them remedied. The report will make these details clear.

"Meanwhile every family in this State that is peculiarly interested in the hospital should demand that all the facts be known and proper means taken to remedy the evils. None of us can afford to ignore the needs of these unfortunates, whose condition is now a disgrace to our State. We have the opportunity to step into the first rank in our care of the insane, and the people are sure to take it if they are knowing the facts."
