What Roads Owe to Salt.
Roads, we are told, owe a great deal to salt. According to one theory, the oldest trade routes came into existence as a result of the traffic in salt. One of the oldest roads in Italy is the Via Salaria, along which the people of the Sabine country obtained their salt from the salt pans of Ostia. Atlanta Jail is Bad.
That white women were hung up on the wall of a cell room, as though crucified, with extended arms, that at least one attempt was made to whip a woman, and that prisoners were used to work for private citizens were some of the things testified to today, in the city council investigation of the city prison, known as the stockade.

Charges that the city prison, to which men and women convicted of misdemeanors and unable to pay a money fine are committed is a filthy place, unworthy of holding even animals, that there has been graft and that barbarous cruelties are practiced there have been made. The grand jurors recently indicted Superintendent Vining and two guards for cruelty and made public a scathing report, which resulted in this investigation.

Ruby Gailher, a country girl, who said she was 19 years old, was the star witness of the day. After the grand jurors had described the prison as "the dirtiest, foulest place on earth, dirtier than any pig pen," the girl was called.

She told how she was sent to the stockade after her mother remarried, because she fought with her stepbrothers, and how one day she was struck by another woman prisoner. She struck back, and fearing to be punished, went to Superintendent Vining and reported her infraction of rules.

"Mr. Vining grabbed me," she said, "and snatched a hand-cuff around my wrist. He and another guard dragged me to the wall in the cell room and hooked my arm to a ring in the wall. The ring was so high that I could not stand on my feet, but had to stand on my tip-toes. I told Vining that I was ill, and suffering, but he paid no attention to me. I was hung there for nearly an hour in agony before I fainted. I do not know how long I was hanging, but I was down, and the doctor was attending to me when I recovered consciousness."

The witness told of seeing another girl, also white hanging by both wrists. A third girl was hung up, but her hands were so small that she slipped through the handcuffs. This same girl, the witness swore, was put in the whipping machine, a big wooden chair, invented by Vining, in which the victim is placed, fastened and then turned over for the application of the lash. The lash is a heavy leather strap, with large metal rivets studded in its surface. This girl, Pearl Ryan, was so small, however, that she slipped through the chair, and the guards gave up the attempt to beat her.

The Superintendent and the guards are indicted for cruelly beating a negro. Another negro died a few days ago from blood poisoning caused by shackles rusting on his legs and cutting into the flesh. When prisoners arrived at the stockade shackles were riveted on over their clothing, and no matter how long they were held, they could not remove their clothing. Only lye soap was furnished the prisoners, and they got no towels.

The investigation will continue tomorrow, and over a hundred witnesses have been summoned.
