Eugene Bishop retired from Plant No. 2 Weaving earlier this month. He had been employed in Plant No. 2 Weaving since January 12, 1959.



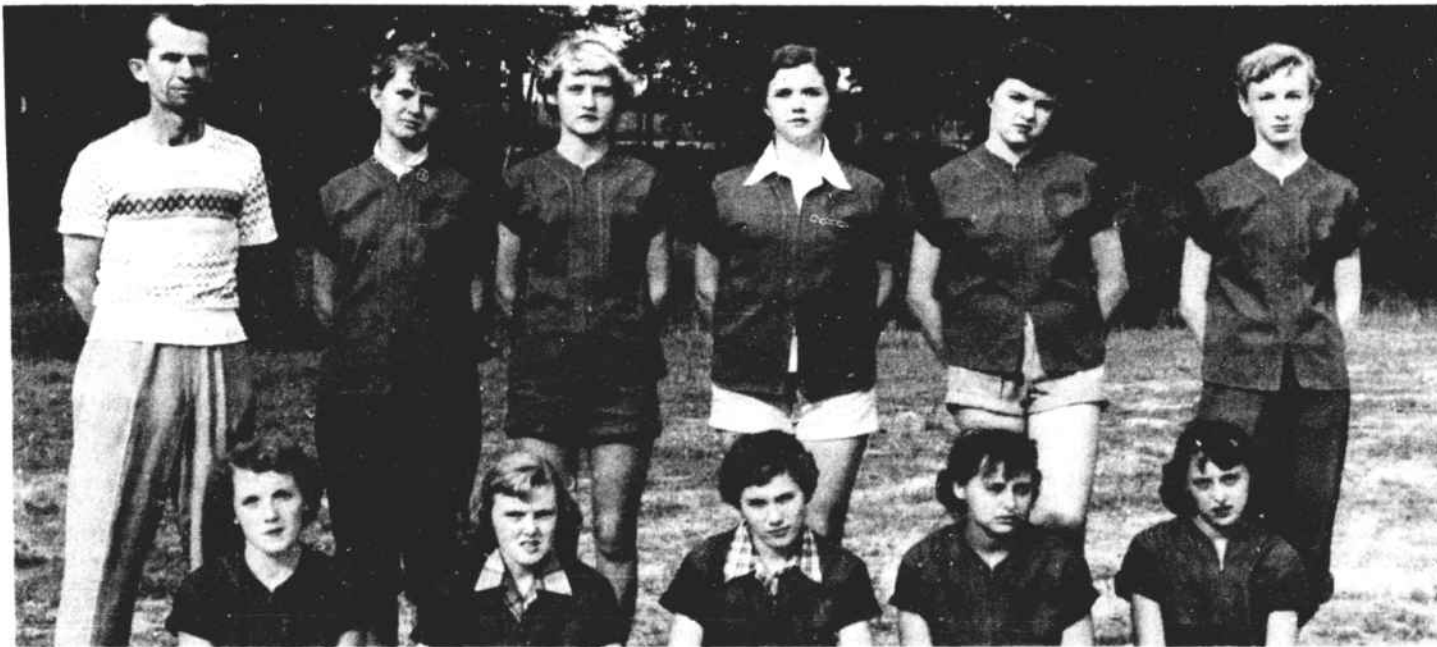
