In the highway department the \$8,000 to pay the Santee bridge commission for services was stricken out and another cut of \$5,000 made.

A proviso was added to the sinking fund commission section so as to allow the sinking fund commission to borrow, if necessary, money to cover the outstanding loans owed by the university.

The contingent fund was raised from \$68,000 to \$98,000.

Senator Pearce and Representative Sapp both made statistical statements on the floor of the two houses showing how the money would be raised this year under the appropriation bill.

The appropriation bill as agreed to by the free conference committee, carries a total appropriation of \$5,839,106.04 or in round numbers a reduction of \$1,000,000 below the appropriation of 1921.

"One of the first laws of chemistry has been that the so-called elements are permanent and unchangeable. The failure of the alchemists, after centuries of efforts, to change such common metals as copper and iron into gold convinced chemists that the metals could not be decomposed.
