To provide for the calling of a convention of the People of this State.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, now met and sitting in General Assembly, and by the authority of the same, That a convention of the people of the State of South Carolina is hereby ordained to be assembled in the City of Columbia, on the 17th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty, for the purpose of taking into consideration the dangers incident to the position of the State in the Federal Union.

Sec. 2. That on the 6th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty, the Managers of elections for the several Districts in the State shall, after giving public notice as in and to the said Convention, open the Polls and hold elections in their respective Districts for Delegates to the said Convention, in all respects in the same manner and form, and at the same places, as elections are now conducted for Members of the Legislature.
