MILLEDGEVILLE, January 19.

The Ordinance of Secession was adopted, to-day, at 2 o'clock. The vote stood yes 208; nays 89—a majority of 119!

WASHINGTON, January 19.

In the Senate, Mr Sumner introduced a resolution for information relative to correspondence with foreign authorities, concerning clearances from Charleston. It was adopted.

THE KANSAS BILL was debated and amended.

It will pass on Monday probably. The \$5,000,000 loan was opened to-day. The Bank of Commerce, of New York, bid for upwards of the whole amount; besides many others for large and small amounts.

A correspondent of the Laurensville Herald,

writing from Fort Moultrie, speaking of the Columbia Artillery, says: "The officers and men are noble fellows. A goodly number of the best young men of Columbia. MILLEDGEVILLE, January 23.

Gov. Brown yesterday communicated to the convention the threatening resolutions adopted by the New York Legislature on the 11th inst. After their reading Mr. Towhee offered the following: "Resolved unanimously, as a response to the resolutions of New York, that this Convention highly approves of the energetic and patriotic conduct of the Governor of Georgia in taking possession of Fort Pulaski, through the State troops, and request him to hold possession of the same until the relations of Georgia with the Federal Government be determined by this convention; and a copy of this resolution is ordered to be transmitted to the Governor of New York."

Collector of Charleston.

WASHINGTON January 23.—The Collector of Charleston has rendered his accounts to the Treasurer to December 25, and paid over the balance due to the Sub-Treasurer at Charleston. It is understood that the government will give an order to the Sub-Treasurer, so that he can compensate the mail contractors there for what the Government has engaged to pay them over and above what is collected at the several Post Offices. The total thus paid by the Government last year, in eight cotton States, is about \$2,000,250.
