

Plan for Forming Farmers' Combine.

Based on a Warehouse in Every County in the State—Rev. Mr. Sublett's Ideas Given.

The State, 5th inst.

Rev. R. A. Sublett of Clarendon was in the city yesterday on his return from the Baptist convention at Chester and had something to say about the proposed meeting of the farmers here this week.

Mr. Sublett said that his plan is to erect a warehouse wherever 10,000 bales of cotton can be gotten together; if in one county there are that number of bales represented by the farmers willing to go into the organization, then to erect a warehouse in that county.

These county organizations would be merged in a State association, composed of one delegate from each of the county warehouses.

Twelve Million Bales Government Estimate.

Market Breaks Heavily on Announcement of the Bureau's Figures, Dropping Half a Cent a Pound.

Washington, Dec. 2.—Preliminary returns to the chief bureau of statistics, Department of Agriculture, show a total production of cotton in the United States in the year 1904-1905 of 12,162,000 bales.

MARKET CRUMBLING.

New York, Dec. 2.—The government estimate of the cotton crop was a surprise and the announcement was followed by another sensational break in prices.

NEW ORLEANS WILD.

New Orleans, Dec. 8.—A heavy slump marked the announcement of the bureau report on the cotton exchange today and wild scenes followed around the ring.

Prices fell from 48 to 52 points within a few minutes, representing about \$2.50 per bale. January traded to 7.88, March to 8.02, and May to 8.04.
