Mrs. Rogers to Hang.

First Woman Executed in Vermont in Seventy Years.

Rutland, Vt., Jan 12 .- Gov. Charles J. Bell of Walden, who for weeks has been urged by hun dreds of persons all over the coun try, to commute and not to com mute the sentence of Mrs Rogers to be hanged next month for husband's murder, has now given his final decision in the matter. He says:

"I see no reason why the law of Vermont should not take their course. No matter what my personal views on capital punishment, I do not consider that I have any right to inierfere with the laws of the State. I was elected by the people to enforce and not set aside the laws of the Common wealth."

This makes it certain that Mrs Mary Rogers will be hanged in the State prison at Winsor on February 5. She will be the first woman to pay the death penalty in Vermont in seventy years.
