Jacksonville, Fla., Jan. 21.—Isham Edwards, George Caldwell and Nelson Larkin, negroes, were found guilty late last night at Tallahassee of the murder of N. W. Eppes, superintendent of public instruction of Leon county, who was killed last August. Judge Malone today sentenced the three to be hanged.
