# ROADS

Plan Adopted for the Formation of Association in Every Connty.

President F. H. Hyatt of the South Carolina Good Roads association is arranging to publish a pamphlet containing the constitution and by-laws of the association and the plan of organization, arranged by the secretary, Mr. Earle Sloan, for the formation of branch associations in the different counties. The books will also contain the names of the county supervisors and other interesting information.

The plan is as follows:

A branch association of the Scuth Carolina Good Roads association may be organized in each county of the State of South Carolina in the following man-

1. The county supervisor and one or more of the county commissioners of the related county shall be advertisement in a coun ty paper issue "a call for all good citizens of ---- county who may be interested in good roads to assemble at the court house to organize the county branch of the South Car olina Good Roads association on the - day of ----, 19-, at the honr of -.

2. That at the specified time the supervisor shall call the meeting to order, read the ad vertisement announcing the pur pose of the meeting, and appoint a temporary secretary who shall submit for the signatures of all intended members present the following form:

"We, the undersigned, do hereby subscribe ourselves as members of the ---- branch of the South Carolina Good Roads association subject to the constitution provided for such branch associations.

(Signatures follow.)

3. The county supervisor shall then appoint three tellers and call for the election of a president by a majority vote of the listed members.

4. The president so elected shall then take the chair and successively call for and require the election of a vice-president, a secretary and a treasurer, by a majarity vote of the listed members.

5. The convention shall then adopt the following constitution :

(a) The -- branch of the South Carolina Good Roads as sociation shall comprise as permanent members all citizens in good standing who may from time to time subscribe to the roll of this association.

(b) The officers of thebranch of the South Carolina Good Roads association shall be a president, a vice president, a secretary and a treasurer, whose term of office shall be coordinate with the term of office of the county supervisor. The county supervisor and one or more of the county commissioners shall ex officia constitute an executive into joy. TO ORGANIZE FOR GOOD members and be ex officio chairman of the county delegation to the South Caro'ina Good Roads association.

> (e) The ---- branch assoiation shall meet not less than once a year at such times as may be agreed on and as much often, er as the executive board may from time to time determine.

> (f) All matters of appeal or contest which may arise shall be referred to the South Carolina Good Roads association whose decision shall be final and binding. -The State.


