President Smith Advises that Arrangements be Made with Local Bankers for Necessary Advances - What the Movement Has Accomplished.

To the People of the State Who Are Interested in the Southern Cotton Association: In view of Mr Smith, in addition to being the numerous inquiries that have president of the South Carolina come to me by those who are Association, is financial agent for bolding spot cotton as to what all States east of the Mississippi method they can secure a loan on and has visited a number of cities their cotton to meet their pressing necessities, I call on the several Mr F H Hyatt, treasurer of county organizations to appoint a committee consisting of their chairman and three other members to see their local bankers at once and arrange plans by which those needing the money can secure a loan on their cotton.
