The case against the Patterson woman was handed to the grand jury again today. Late this afternoon the jury handed down indictments against Smith, Mrs. Smith and Miss Patterson, charging them jointly with conspiracy to kill Young. The trial will proceed as scheduled, and it is expected that it will be concluded as promptly as conditions will permit.

Feeding Hogs For Market.

W. E. Barley, Before State Swine Breeders' Association, Waxahatchie, Texas.

In presenting this subject we give you our method where a carload or more hogs are fed at one time.

We will not name any breed. Every one interested in hogs prefers some breed, and this is the breed with which a man will make his greatest success. We prefer raising our feeders in preference to buying them. By so doing we can breed the sows, so that the pigs will be almost the same age, and come at a time that will best suit our pasture and corn crop.

We give the hogs about what corn they will eat up clean twice a day while running on pasturage, and we keep plenty of fresh water always before them.

In summer we furnish them with plenty of cool shade, and in winter we sleep them in a long shed open to the south, with dirt floor and partitions every ten feet to prevent them from piling up.

Rake up all cobs and burn them. Water out when charred good and let the hogs eat the charcoal.

Keep a trough filled with wood ashes and salt, one measure of salt to six measures of ashes, in a convenient place, so that the hogs may eat of this mixture at any time.

A tablespoonful of turpentine for each hog in slop once a week is very beneficial.
