## American Trade Company Formed in Russia

Petrograd, Aug. 30.—Foreseeing the inevitable growth of industry after the war and the necessity of attracting foreign capital to Russia at the present time organizations are being formed to act as intermediaries to that end. An enterprise has just been established in Moscow under the initiative of Prince I. A. Volkonsky, known as the "Russian-American Trade and industry company," the object of which is to attract American capital and to further the import of American goods required by Russian industry. The capital is 1,000,000 rubles (nomally \$500,000).
