Report of the Charleston Cotton Market for the Week Ending Oct. 21.
Reported for the Orangeburg News by W. WALTON SMITH, COTTON FACTOR.

There has been considerable irregularity in our market during the week. On Friday, the first day of the week, under review, the market opened with a declining tendency, owing to the depression in the New York market, and prices fell off 1 to 1/2 c. on our closing quotations of last week. On Saturday the market was quite active under favorable news from Liverpool, and the decline of the day before was fully recovered. The demand continued active throughout Monday, and prices advanced from 1 to 1/2 c. On Tuesday the demand was very light, with a decline of 1/2 c. on prices of the day previous. The market opened on Wednesday with a good demand, and buyers operated freely at a further decline of 1 to 1/2 c. On Thursday the demand continued good, the market opening with an additional decline of 1/2 c. which was fully regained after the receipt of favorable news from Liverpool. The sales for the week amount to near 30000 bales, the market closing at the following quotations:
