Wanted at New Orleans. (From the New Orleans Times, Dec. 1.)

The first quarter of the financial and commercial year 1865 and 1866 closes this evening. In some respects business has been attended with great regularity, so far as the great product, cotton, has been concerned.

Nor can the improvement and increase with the country bordering on the Jackson Railroad be overlooked as forming a component part of the general recuperation of business.

The exchange market to-day offered nothing for either general or special remark. The bank counter rates for checks on New York opened at three-eighths to one-half discount.

Corrosive.—The market opened this morning with a fair inquiry for prices, but factors feeling reassured by the favorable reaction at Liverpool being confirmed in the morning papers, and the New York accounts being less discouraging, were unwilling to meet the demand unless at rather stiffer rates.
