Next week we will publish all the particulars concerning the plot near Faxonville, and of some persons who are giving it in full. It seems that a portion of the men were rescued, who had gone to arrest parties charged with whipping a colored man who was said to have owned the Democratic ticket. In the quarrel Mr. DeLoach was killed and Mr. Shuman wounded, one colored man was killed and his wife wounded. The report of the disturbance spread with rapidity which brought lands of armed men from Barnwell and the surrounding country who picketed the roads. About five hundred armed and mounted men were at the scene, and it was only the coolness and bravery of Sheriff Wilson that prevented a serious riot. The colored people are leaving that section of the country. All the state arms were taken from the militia, and the rioters dispersed. Twenty-seven are now under arrest and confined in jail. All the colored men save themselves up, and many walked to Beaufort for the purpose. The reports of the News correspondent from this place is incorrect as to the arrests made here. The reports of outrages upon the body of Mr. DeLoach is denied by reliable persons who were present and the report circulated is sensational and malicious. There is two sides to the story of the riot, and both seem to be wrong. The colored men for resisting the posse, and the white for concentrating with arms in stead of calling upon the lawful authorities.

The whole affair seems to be the result of heat and bitterness in the late canvass.
