It seems that a posses of feer men was resisted, who had gone to arre t! parties charged with whipping a colored man who was said to have voted the demcratic ticket. In the quarrel Mr. De-Loach was killed and Mr. Shuman wonnded, one colored man was killed and his wife wounded. The report of the diturbance spread with rapidity which brought hands of armed men from Barnwell and the surrounding country who picketed the roads. About five hundred | 2 w. armed and mounted men were at the seene, and it was only the coolness and bravery of Sheriff Wilson that prevented a serious riot. The colored people are leaving that section of the country. All the state arms were taken from the miltia, and the rioters dispersed. Twentyseven are now under arrest and confine! in jail. All the colored men mye themselves up, and many walked to Beaufort for the purpose. The reports of the News correspondent from this place is incorrect as to the arrests made here.

The reports of outrages upon the body of Mr. Deloach is denied by reliable persons who were present and the report circulated is sensational and malicious.

There is two sides, to the story of the riot, and both seem to be wrong. The colored men for resisting the possee, and the whites for concentrating with arms in stead of calling upon the lawful authori-The whole affair seems to be the result of heat and bitterners in the late canvass.
