 What has he done in this way? He was asked by the representatives of the Farmers Union to make the argument for the Warehouse bill before the Supreme Court. The question was of prime importance to the farmers because if the State could build warehouses and the farmers could store their cotton in them and get a receipt on which the money could be gotten, and the rates were low, it would enable the farmers to hold their cotton in time of panic until the price should rise.

He is a lawyer who believes constitutions to be practical and took the position before the Court that the State had the power to relieve and protect its citizens from financial oppression, just as it would have the right to protect them from military oppression. The Court agreed with him and practically adopted his brief but held that two unnecessary provisions in the bill were in violation of the constitution, and the bill would have to be drawn as to leave them out to be effective. But the right of the state to warehouse its farmers' cotton was established in this case; and whenever they make up their minds to have it done it can be done.

He did this work purely for the good of the cause, without fee or reward. If he was in congress wouldn't he be on the same side, fighting the cotton speculation in New York? Give him a chance and if he doesn't mean up—throw him out.
