An election is hereby ordered to be held in Pageland, S. C. on Thursday, September 10th, 1914, on the question of establishing a State High School in Pageland School district 43, within the meaning of acts 1824 to 1835 inclusive of the code of 1912. At said election persons residing in said district, who return real or personal property for taxation, and who are otherwise qualified to vote as in general elections, will be allowed to vote. Said election does not involve the levy or collection of any tax other than the present levy, but is held for the purpose of enabling the district to qualify for state aid within the meaning of the above statutes.
