Pageland Novelty Works

Ordinance No. 34

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Pageland in council assembled that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to park or stop any automobile or motor truck on McGregor street from Maple street to Sycamore street; or on east side of Pearl street from McGregor street to the Journal office, for a period of more than ten minutes.
