

SAILED OVER SAN FRANCISCO.

Dr. Greth Directs His Flying Machine for Two Hours.

San Francisco, Cal., Oct. 18.—Dr. August Greth, who for a year past has been working on an air ship, to-day surprised the residents of San Francisco, by sailing over their heads for two hours, directing his machine almost at will and demonstrating that in many essentials he has solved the problem of aerial navigation. Dr. Greth had previously tested his air ship by making ascensions with the balloon held captive by a long rope, but today was the first time he had gone skyward free.

TRAIN BREAKS SPEED RECORDS

Special on Illinois Central Makes Fast Time to New Orleans.

New Orleans, Oct. 15.—Nearly 100 general passenger agents from all parts of the country, who arrived here tonight on a special Illinois Central train to attend the forty eighth annual convention of the American Association of General Passenger and Ticket Agents, which will be held at the St. Charles Hotel to-morrow, were treated to a record-breaking ride, which they will long remember.

The run was the most remarkable in the history of Southern railroads—189 miles were made in 187 minutes 105 miles in 90 minutes, including stops, and 396 miles in 402 minutes, exclusive of stops. At times and for short distances of one mile and under the speed indicator in the observation car registered 94.4 miles per hour. According to recent speed tests made by the Pennsylvania Railroad this is within six-tenths of a mile of being as fast as it is possible to run a modern passenger train.

The train was composed of engine, buffet, library car, diner, five standard Pullmans and an observation car. The total weight of the train was about 351 tons, or 1,102,000 pounds.

The passenger agents' convention will last three days, during which business and pleasure will be mingled. Cleveland and St. Louis are bidding for the next convention.

The result was that Motte Gunter, of New Brookland, Lexington County, severely beat J. E. Busbee, of this place.
