Deep down in every man's heart, when under high passion and often in cooler moments, is a desire to be his own avenger. This coupled with the toleration upon which it has been fostered, fed and fattened, was the prime moving cause, and not that they feared an impartial trial. This state of things is simply horrible and in the name of God and humanity let this bloody practice cease at once and forever. As they have many of these offenders in the toils, let the State vindicate her honor and uphold her dignity, or the time is not far distant, when any of us, by a well concerted plan may have a train of circumstances fixed around us—a put up job—jerked from our beds at midnight, on bare suspicion, and led away by a hooting mob to execution. Let Culbreth be the last martyr in such a cause!

COUNTY CONVENTION.

The convention which met on the 31st inst. and nominated Maj. Henry B. Richardson to fill the unexpired term of the late Arthur Harvin in the Legislature, was composed of some of the most prominent men of the County. The deliberations of the body were conspicuous for the general harmony and good feeling which seemed to pervade the assembly. There was no wire pulling, no caustic speeches or partisan feeling displayed—the usual result of political assemblies. The entire business of the occasion was despatched promptly and impartially, and without one unpleasant occurrence the gratifying nomination was reached.
