"Radial expansion" by hydraulic pressure to obtain the necessary adherent strength, or elasticity, in the "built up" weapons is the basis of the new plan. It will reduce the number of sections in the guns as compared to the heat shrinking process, the report states, and can be applied to guns up to six-inch rifles, but it has not been worked out for heavy weapons.



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

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
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
