Clarence Chestnut, working like a veteran, put the ball where the batters were not expecting it and caused ten men to miss the third strike. Congress Gives Money to Locate Tobacco Markets

EXPERTS BE SENT ABROAD TO FIND NEW TRADE FOR WEED

Washington, Mar. 23.—With the passage by both houses of congress of the appropriation bill making provision for an increased personnel of tobacco experts to visit foreign lands and locate markets for American tobacco interests, a long step will have been taken towards extending our tobacco markets in South Carolina and elsewhere. Just as soon as possible arrangements will be made by Doctor Klein for purchase, who is chiefly responsible for this legislation and the State's representative results are expected to follow soon.

There is no lump sum appropriated for this work," Mr. Byrns said, "but it is the opinion of Dr. Klein, chief of the bureau of foreign and domestic commerce of the department of commerce and others associated with him, that whereas, there is at this time no special tobacco representative abroad, under the new legislation there will be two, certainly and possibly three. It is very satisfying to know that the tobacco markets of all the states, from western Florida, through the two Carolinas, on through Virginia to Tennessee, Kentucky, Ohio, and other sections will receive the benefit of this increased appropriation and personnel. Just as soon as possible arrangements will be made by Doctor Klein for purchase, who is chiefly responsible for this legislation and the State's representative results are expected to follow soon.
