
The purpose of the synchronized program is to enable Kiwanians all over the United States and Canada to concentrate upon the purpose and ideals of the organization.

Arrangements for observing All-Kiwanis night will be completed by President Billy Copeland and our club will enter into the observance as planned by International.


### **Junior Order Officers** Named
