

Pan Dulce

Ten pieces of raw sweet potato one inch sugare and one fourth inch titick.

Four tablespoons full of red con namon drops.

Three fourths cup of water.

Two tablespoon full of sugar. Dissolve the cinnamon drops and sugar in hot water. Drop in the pieces of sweet potato and cook gently until tender and syrup is absorbed. Cut a round of pastry with a scalloped cooky cutter. Spread a piece of candied potato ever half of each round, cutting the outer edge so that it spreads out fanwise over half of the pastry, allowing the edge of the potato to show. Brush the tops with white of egg and bake in a quick
