President Truman's Civil Rights Committee Watches S. C. Lynching

Closest Attention Being Given, Chairman States Emory Burke, Columbian Leader, Given 3-Year Prison Sentence

NEW YORK—The President's Commission on Civil Rights is "deeply concerned" over the lynching in Pickens, S. C., February 17 and the case will "command our closest attention." This was the assertion of Charles E. Wilson, chairman, in a telegram to the NAACP February 17.

Earlier, Walter White, NAACP secretary, had telegraphed Chairman Wilson: "As a basis for recommendations to the President and the Congress we urge an immediate investigation of these lynchings who have further added to the wave of lawlessness which threatened not only minorities, but American democracy as well."

A similar telegram was sent to Attorney General Tom Clark of the Department of Justice.

In addition the NAACP launched its own investigation through the office of its state conference of branches at Columbia, S. C.

SUBJECT TO ATTACKS

NAACP investigators said the victim, Willie Earle, 25, was subject to envious attacks and was not a native of the state.

He is said to have arrived in his home in Liberty, S. C., six miles from Greenville at 10:30 p.m. on Saturday. The robbery and fatal attack on white taxi driver in Greenville occurred Saturday night, the possibility exists, said NAACP investigators in South Carolina, that Earle was innocent, but the white taxi driver died just after "identifying" Earle, so that there is now little chance that anyone else could be held for the crime for which Earle was lynched.

S. C. Primary Challenged In Court

Opening Wedge Against Latest Device Made

COLUMBIA, S. C.—The opening wedge in the fight to detect the Southern states' latest device to keep Negroes from the polls was made by the NAACP in a South Carolina court on February 21st in an effort to regain the Negroes in that state their political rights.

The NAACP filed suit in the federal district court for the western district of S. C. against the election managers and the Democratic Executive Committee of Richland County for their refusal to permit Negroes to vote in the 1946 primary.

The NAACP also filed suit in the state court for the same purpose.

Vets Can Renew War Policy By August 1

Veterans wishing to renew war insurance policies can do so any time before August 1, which gives them six months more than the original deadline date of February 1. A congressional order set the new date last Friday.

Meanwhile, the National Service Life Insurance Agency at Atlanta, announced that a veteran can increase or reduce his policy and that he needs no physical examination to have it reinstated. He can not hold more than \$10,000 worth, however.

NSLI applies only to veterans of World War I. It was created in 1917 and is operated by the government. Its rates are lowest in the country and despite this fact, it reports that so many men took policies as a "must" when they went into service that veterans grew a dislike for it.

Not all veterans had \$50,000 policies during the war, as many people thought. The enlisted man could take whatever policy he wanted. Most of the men took policies ranging upward from \$500.

The low rates of these policies, which can be held and used just as those of private companies, but at much less cost, is seen in the following example of a man 25 years of age. Ordinary Life, \$1.37 monthly; 30-day life, \$1.67 monthly; Endowment at age 67, \$1.89 monthly. These are for a policy with a face value of \$1,000.

A vet needs only to obtain a blank from any veteran center, such as those at Fort Jackson, The Veterans Hospital or the Veterans Regional office. This is completed and along with the premium is mailed to the NSLI office in Atlanta. Payment may be made at the places listed above but they would in turn forward the same to Atlanta, only collection point.

AME's To Try Bishop Davis On New Charges March 6

ATLANTA, Ga.—S. C. Bishop Davis, president of the race, was sentenced to three years in prison Friday in Pickens County Superior Court. Sentence was passed by Judge C. E. Crow of the Albany district, who presided over the trial.

George W. Thomas, counsel for the Columbian leader, had a motion for a new trial, which Judge Crow granted to hear in Columbia, May 15.

Officers Nab Earle Lynchers; 28 Taxi Drivers, 3 Others To Face Trial On Charges Pressed By State And County

GREENVILLE, S. C.—Solicitor Robert T. Ashmore disclosed Monday plans to seek for a special term of Criminal court to deal with 31 white men, 28 of them drivers, charged in a warrant drawn before City Magistrate Bates Aiken, Friday night with the lynch-slaying of 23-year-old Willie Earle, whose blasted, gaped and mutilated body was found at 6:15 a. m. Monday, four miles west of here 40 minutes after a mob removed him from the Pickens county jail.

Solicitor Ashmore's announcement was in line with the known will of state and county authorities to push speedy and vigorous prosecution. The regular term of Criminal court opens March 10. The solicitor was due to confer in a day or so with Circuit Judge J. Robert Martin to set bail in the case. Some men, he said, might be allowed lower bail than others.

DROVE FOR 5 COMPANIES

The suspects were three businessmen, one of whom had not been jailed Monday being out of the state on business, and 28 from five taxi companies, 19 from the Yellow Cab company, 23 from the Commercial and Greenville cab companies, 7 from the Blue Bird and 5 from American.

The businessmen include 37-year-old Walter Oakley, part owner of the Raleigh Cafe across from Yellow Cab headquarters on West Court; John B. Marshall, 28 and Earle E. Martin, yet to be jailed.
