**SALE OF ARMY FOOD.**

Washington, July 26.—Direct action aimed at the high cost of living expected by congress next week as a result of increasing pressure in the entire nation for relief.

A resolution ordering the war department to sell its huge surplus stores of food direct to the public will be voted up in the house Tuesday with apparently good prospects of passing.

This action would result in thousands of pounds of bacon, ham and canned vegetables being sold throughout the country at once.

Attempts of speculators to purchase this food when it is put up for sale have been a failure and the department is determined to sell direct to consumers.

**CROWN PRINCE IS VERY HOME-SICK**

Want to Get Back to Germany to See in Rehabilitating the Fatherland

Berlin, July 26.—The former crown prince of Germany, in his address in Washington, is expressing his homesickness "which grows stronger daily," and is looking forward to the time when he can return to Germany to assist in rehabilitating the fatherland.

This was revealed in a letter by the prince May 1, printed in the second edition of Capt. Dan Anders' book just published.



After depicting the present plight of Germany, the former crown prince wrote:

"Both myself and my family wish, in spite of our completely altered conditions, to build up a new life. Still more ardently do I await the moment, should it be granted, when I can again have a little place in Germany, where I can assist in rebuilding the beloved fatherland. Give my greetings to my friends and believe me that my homesickness grows stronger daily."

**FOCH WANTS 6,000 SAMBIES ON RHINE**

Paris July 26.—Marshal Foch recommended today that a force of 6,000 Americans be stationed in Upper Silesia as an army of occupation. His recommendation was included in a statement to the council of five in which he advised that the allies maintain 150,000 troops as an occupation force in the Rhine district.

Upper Silesia was ceded to Poland under the terms of the treaty, but provision was made for a plebiscite to decide whether the people wished to remain a part of Poland, return to Germany or form their own government. On account of disturbed conditions, the plebiscite was delayed until all troops should be withdrawn during the plebiscite.
