## Come to the Tri-county Fair To Be Held At Batesburg OCTOBER 15, 16, 17 and 18.

The Lexington, Saluda and Aiken County Fair will be held at Batesburg this year on the above named dates at their new Fair Grounds in the Town of Batesburg. The Fair Association will have spent on their grounds and buildings the opening year something like four or five thousand dollars. They own and have enclosed ten acres of the prettiest land in the town of Batesburg overlooking both towns. The handsome two-story Main Fair Building, 100 feet long by 30 feet wide has been erected. In this main building will be exhibited field crops, fancy work, manufactured products, etc. About 100 conveniently arranged and well constructed horse and cattle stalls have been built.

A large and convenient poultry house is provided to care for a thousand turkeys, ducks and pigeons, and ample stalls are being provided for goats, sheep and hogs. It is earnestly hoped that every farmer will bring to the Fair his stock poultry or field crop, and every lady her flowers, needle and fancy work or other domestic work, so that each county will be creditably represented.

Suitable premiums have been arranged and will be paid to the successful contestants. Special Railroad rates of one fare plus 25 cents have been granted from Augusta, Columbia and Allendale and intermediate points. An excellent band of music will be employed to assist in the entertainment of visitors. The Batesburg Opera House will furnish entertainment for the visitors during the evenings.
