SUMMER SCHOOL AT WINTHROP COLLEGE

Rock Hill, March 20.—Teachers representing every phase of teaching are writing to Winthrop college for copies of the Summer School Bulletin.

Last summer there were 605 teachers enrolled necessitating a faculty of 64 officers and teachers. Of those 17 attendance last summer 118 held college degrees, 74 were superintendents, principals and high school teachers.

Some of Those Secured. The entire faculty has not as yet been announced, but the services for the following have been secured for the coming session:

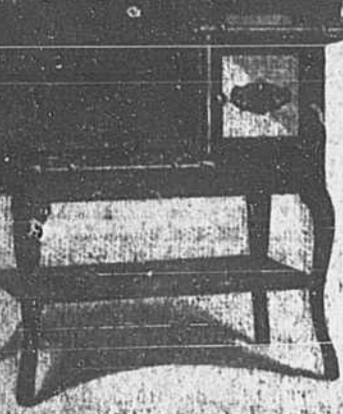

MADE CONTRACT FOR WHITE WAY

WORK WILL BEGIN ON ITS CONSTRUCTION AT ONCE

OVER 100 POSTS

George Miller Says That Local System Will Be Complete In Every Respect

Following a conference on Friday at 3 o'clock in the city hall, Mayor McGowan and George Miller and Elmore closed a contract with George Miller for a "great white way" for Anderson and Mr. Miller at once telegraphed to the manufacturers of the white way posts to rush the required number of posts to the city.

When it became known last night that the council had closed a contract for the system the people of the city were well pleased. Numbers of the business men of the city said that they considered it one of the best steps that the council had ever taken and the action of the body was generally endorsed on every side.

In talking with a reporter for The Intelligencer, Mr. Miller said that he did not know just how long it would take for the new posts to arrive, but he expected the manufacturers to have no time in getting the posts on the road and that the work would be then pushed as rapidly as possible as soon as the material reached here.

This system will cost approximately \$10,000 but under the terms of agreement between Mr. Miller and the city council, the city of Anderson will not pay one cent for the improvement, as they were merely required to close a contract that would keep the white way in operation for the next 10 years and pay for current consumption of the posts at the rate of \$35 per post per annum.

Mr. Miller stated to The Intelligencer reporter last night that the system proposed for the city will be the most complete in the entire South from the standpoint of covering the entire business district, and that the special display as arranged for the square will give a setting to the system unobtainable usually elsewhere.

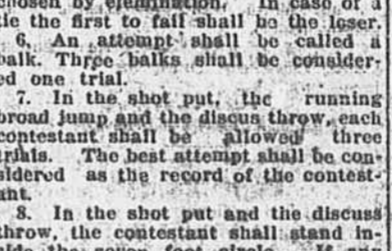

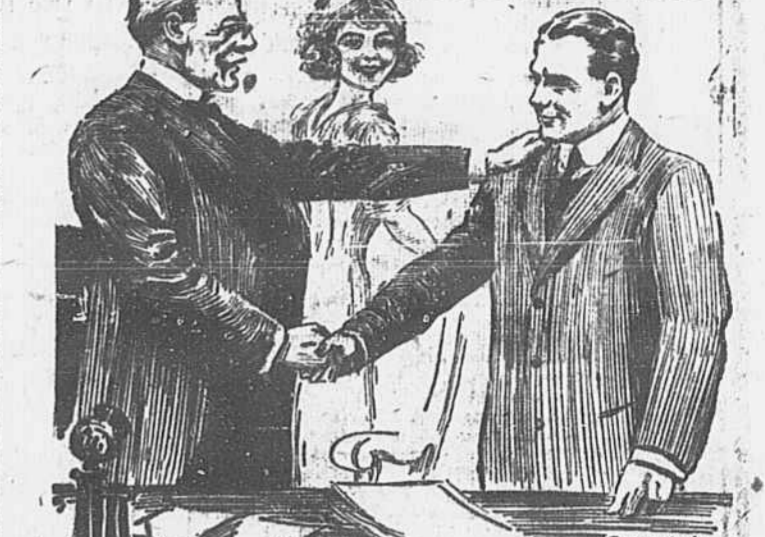
