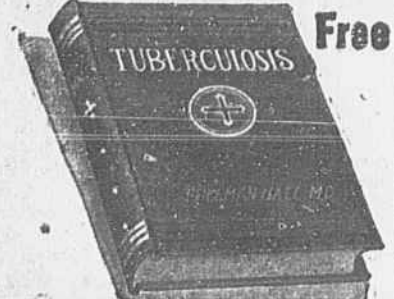

AUSTRIA GROWLS RUSSIA SNARLS

TWO NATIONS ARE VERY UNFRIENDLY TOWARD EACH OTHER

NO WAR IN SIGHT

Each Country Has Too Much At Stake to Get Into a Fight With Formidable Adversary

Vienna, May 12.—One of the shrewdest members of the diplomatic corps in Vienna, when asked recently about the relations between Austria-Hungary and Russia, bluntly answered that there were none.

For something past there has been considerable tension in the relations between the two empires, the precise reasons for which are difficult to explain.

Up to the time of the Austrian annexation of Bosnia and Herzegovina in 1908, the relations between the two countries had been quite friendly.

The personal relations between the two imperial families are of the most cordial character. It is sometimes even said that the Hapsburgs are really pro-Russian.

Archduke Charles Louis who was the patron of the principle Austrian industrial associations and a very far-sighted man, perceived the very important role of commerce and industry.

The sympathies and feelings of the two governments and the two peoples are very different from those prevailing between the rulers.

The fight is mainly a religious one, Russia wanting to bring all the Balkans under the sway of the Orthodox church and to force the Roman Catholic part of the population, as well as the Mohammedans to acknowledge the supremacy of the Russian church.

The federal garrison at San Blas, a port 125 miles further south had evacuated the town, it was reported. The garrison moved, it was declared in the direction of Mexico city, the idea being given that Huerta was drawing available troops to assist him in maintaining himself in the capital.

From the Pacific coast came a report that desultory fighting continued at Mazatlan between General Obregon's constitutionalists and the federal garrison.

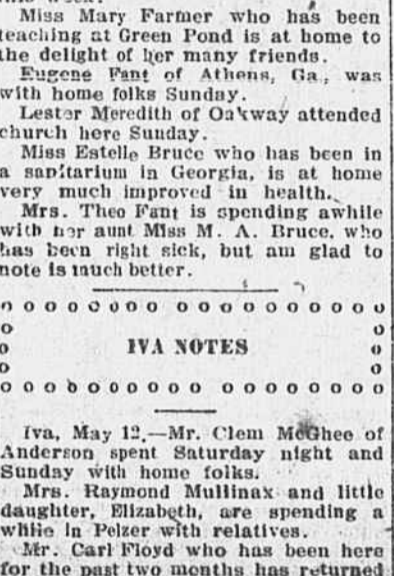
Too Many People Leaving the Farms For Cities
