New York, April 6.—Spot quiet; middling 1940; gulf 1365. Cotton futures closed steady.

New Orleans Cotton

New Orleans, La., April 6.—Liquidation of long cotton, mixed with scattered fresh spot selling weighed against the price of cotton today.

Liquidation appeared to be stimulated by the approaching Easter holidays. Owners of long contracts seemed anxious to reduce their holdings.

The ring showed a marked change over the conditions prevailing last week, when, up to the close, the demand was for contracts.

Spot cotton, steady, unchanged. Middling 13 1/2-16 sales on spot 630; to arrive 630.

Liverpool Cotton

Liverpool, April 6.—Cotton, spot steady; good middling 77; middling 73; low middling 692. Sales 10,000; speculation and export 1,000. Receipts none. Futures barely steady.

Cotton Seed Oil

New York April 6.—Cottonseed oil higher on buying of July for Western account, light offerings in general and support from the bulls. Final prices were 2 to 3 points net higher.

Cotton Goods

New York, April 6.—Cotton goods markets were quiet and steady today. Yarns were easy. Raw silk was unchanged. Dress goods were in moderate demand.

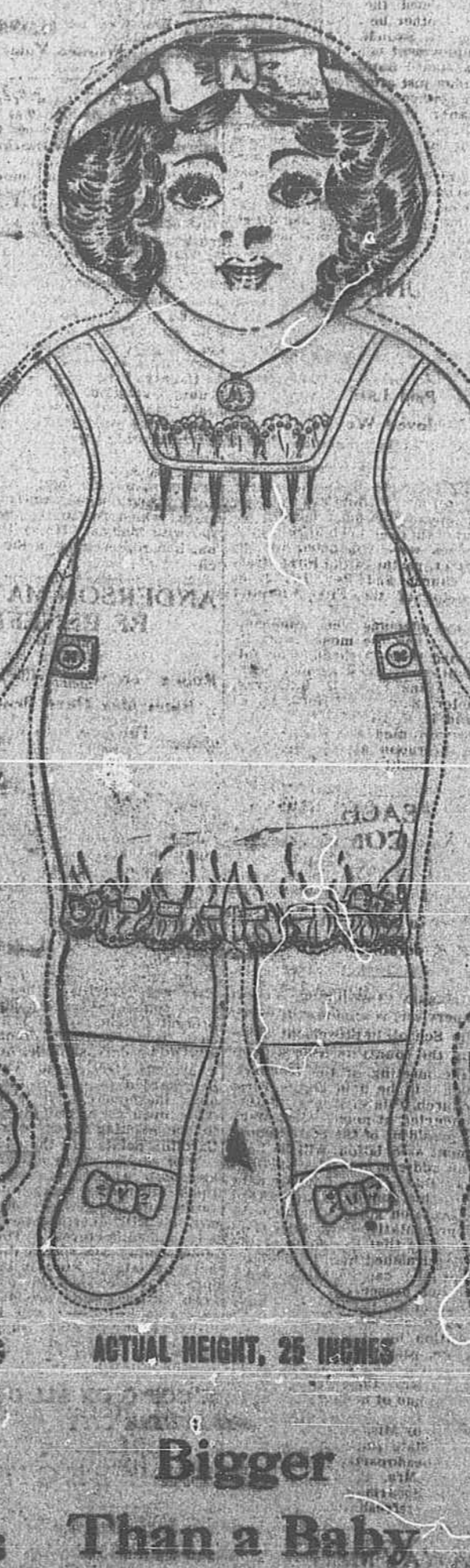
