COURT DISMISSES IMPORTANT CASE

SUIT AGAINST LACKAWANNA FOR VIOLATING SHERMAN LAW THROWN OUT

The United States court here today dismissed the suit of the United States Government against the Lackawanna and Western Railroad Company and the Dole-Aero Corporation, Lackawanna and Western Coal Company for alleged violation of the antitrust law.

The decision was handed down here by Judge Gray, Bullington and McPherson of the Third Judicial Circuit. The action was brought in the Federal court here, but through a certificate of expedition, filed by Attorney General Clegg, it was transferred to the United States court here.
