

NEAR WAR ON IN COLORADO

MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN ENTOMBED IN MINE AFTER IT IS FIRED

MILITIA IS HELPLESS

Battle of Strikers and Troops Lasts All Day and Bloodshed Is Reported Great

(By Associated Press.)

Denver, Colo., April 22.—Green Canyon Mine and Mine No. 9 at Delagua are burning, according to advices received at headquarters of the United Mine Workers here. It was also said women and children from Delagua and Hastings have boarded a freight train for Trinidad.

Manager Murdered

Trinidad, Colo., April 22.—A report said to have been received from Major Hendrick late today stated that Manager J. J. Smith of the Empire and Southwestern Mines, had been killed with several of his men in the Empire Mine, which then had been sealed and fired by strikers.

Bodies of Women Found

Trinidad, Colo., April 22.—The bodies of eleven children, two women and one man were found late today in and about the ruins of the Ludlow tent colony by a searching party sent out from here by the American Coal Owners Association.

The Bodies are Being Brought to Trinidad

Trinidad, Colo., April 22.—Six mine employees dead and two missing; three men, two women and a baby reported to be entombed in a burning mine; several children, women and men, who had been sealed in by strikers; two hundred millionaires and company guards confronting an army of strikers; coal miners estimated by strike leaders at more than four hundred;—this was the situation when the sun set on the third day in the southern Colorado labor war.

Appalling Is Story

The list of dead on the side of the coal mine operators as the result of the day's fighting, included the names of William Weddell, superintendent of Empire and Southwestern Mines of Fuel Company.

A persistent but unconfirmed report is that J. W. Stone, manager of the Empire and Southwestern Mines of the southern Colorado coal fields, had been sealed in the Empire mine, which then had been sealed in by strikers.

one of their fighting men had been killed during the night, and that two had been reported wounded.

According to reports received by military authorities, the fighting at Aguilera, which followed that at Delagua, was participated in by 250 men of the militia.

Little Militia Party

The firing at Delagua began several days ago, with a clash between fifteen guards and a large body of miners. This night occurred in the hills a mile or more from the camp, where the guards are declared to have come to meet the approaching strikers. There was no fighting at close range for a few minutes and then the guards turned toward the camp, the pursuing strikers at their heels. The strikers reached the crest of the canyon directly above the camp, then rushed for the mine building. Mine company reports declared that in this rush dynamite was exploded by the attacking party.

A party of militiamen, hastily sent from Ludlow in steel cars, reinforced the guards and after heavy fighting the strikers were driven back.

Shortly afterward a party of strikers, armed with dynamite, crossed the canyon by a high range of hills. The strikers of Delagua in the direction of Aguilera.

The attacks of the Aguilera mines followed.

Labor headquarters were jammed with strikers at Trinidad and the crowds overflowed to the Aguilera.

Throughout the day steady streams of strikers passed in and out of the mine where by the bodies of several victims of the Ludlow battle.
