

**BLEASE SPEAKS
IN SPARTANBURG**

**DENOUNCES SECRETARY OF
NAVY DANIEL**
STATES HIS POLICIES

Says Some Unprintable Things About Editor Jan H. Moore of Columbia Record

Spartanburg, April 23.—Cole L. Blease made two speeches here today one in the afternoon and the other tonight. Large crowds listened to him outline the platform on which he will make his race for the senate. Fully 2,000 people were in front of the court house tonight, cheering him.

He declared he was proud of his native record, saying he had 311 130 convicts to release, having already extended clemency to over 1,000. He said the conviction incident which led to the prohibition enactment in this state was a disgraceful chapter in the history of the state.

He declared that the only one who is sorry that the role of Blease has not been played is the "blind tiger," the gambler and the keeper of brothels. He said the enactment would be nothing but a "grand drunk."

He held his respects to Secretary Daniels, saying he had had in the Fort Royal incident. He used language in connection with James H. Moore, editor of the Record which would be libelous for a newspaper to print.

Governor Blease opposed medical inspection in the public schools, compulsory education and he advocated the "Curtis bill" prohibiting white teachers teaching in negro schools and vice versa.

He said the crowd is the only man for governor who advocated the prohibition issue has fought for it.

He said he would present the will of George Washington to the senate.

**EDITOR MOORE
GOT "PINCHED"**

Gov. Blease Swore Out Warrant For Libel Against Editor of Columbia Evening Record

Columbia, April 23.—James H. Moore, Editor of the Columbia Record, was arrested this morning in two warrants, sworn out before Judge Oates by the Frank Blackburn, charging him with "wilfully and maliciously, and with malicious intent originating, uttering, circulating and publishing certain false statements, concerning one Cole L. Blease."

Mr. Moore was released under a \$5,000 bond to await court trial. The arrest of Mr. Moore occurred shortly before 10 o'clock this morning in the editorial rooms of the Record, when Deputy Sheriff Heise, in the temporary absence from the city of Sheriff McCain, came in person to serve the papers.

Only the warrant charging a libelous editorial on April 21 was formally served upon the Editor, the deputy temporarily retaining the other. This was produced, however, before Mr. Moore left the Record building in company with deputy and a friend to answer the court summons.

In each of the affidavits, it is charged that the alleged editorial utterances had effect to injure the Cole L. Blease in his reputation with personal and political in violation of an act of the General Assembly.

El Paso, April 23.—General Francisco Villa, head of the rebel military forces, informed George C. Carranza, special agent of the state department, that he will decline to be dragged into a war with the United States by anybody.

He said he was not consulted in the drafting of the Carranza note transmitted to Secretary Bryan last night, and which was regarded as somewhat hostile in tone.

The rebel leader told Carranza who reported the interview to the state department tonight, that one of the chief reasons he came to justice was to show the American people that his attitude was friendly and that he did not fear to face himself at the hands of the U. S. military escort behind him.

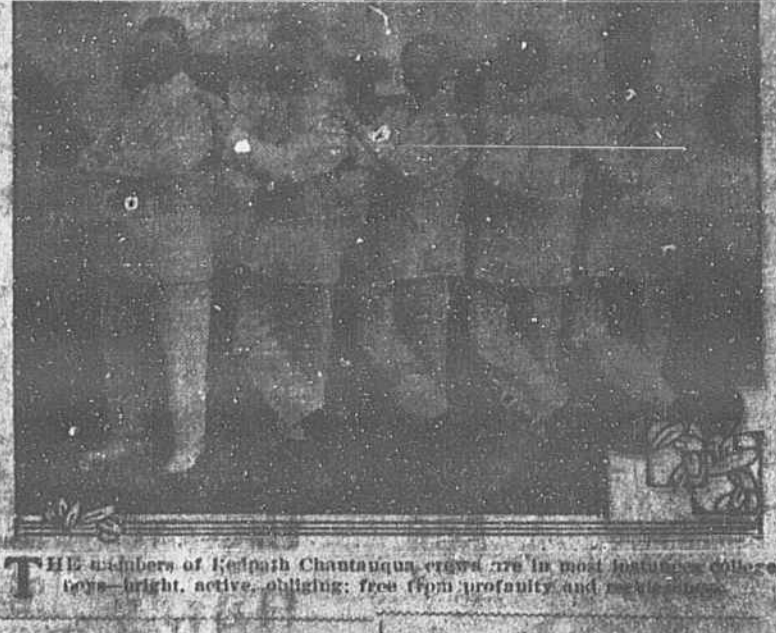
