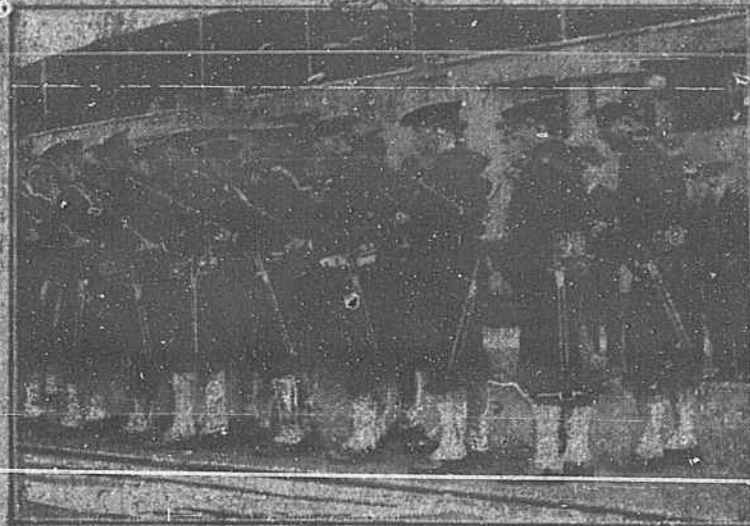
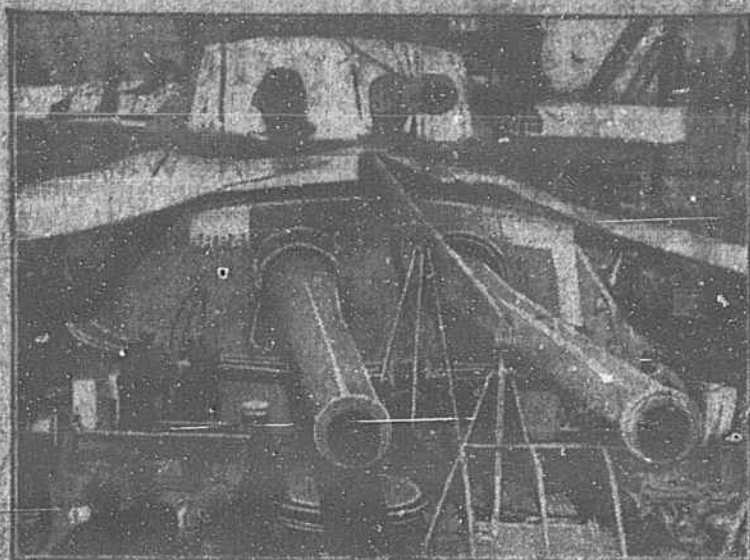


Armed Marines In Mexican Trouble and Guns of the Utah

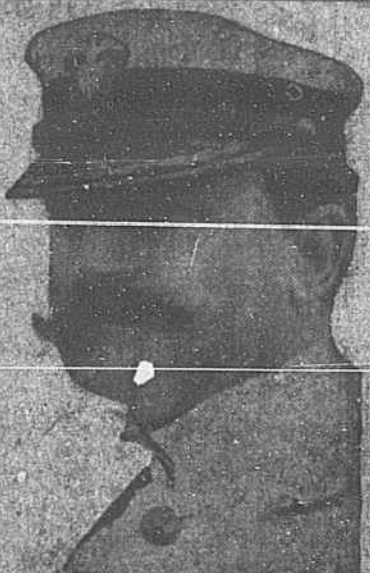

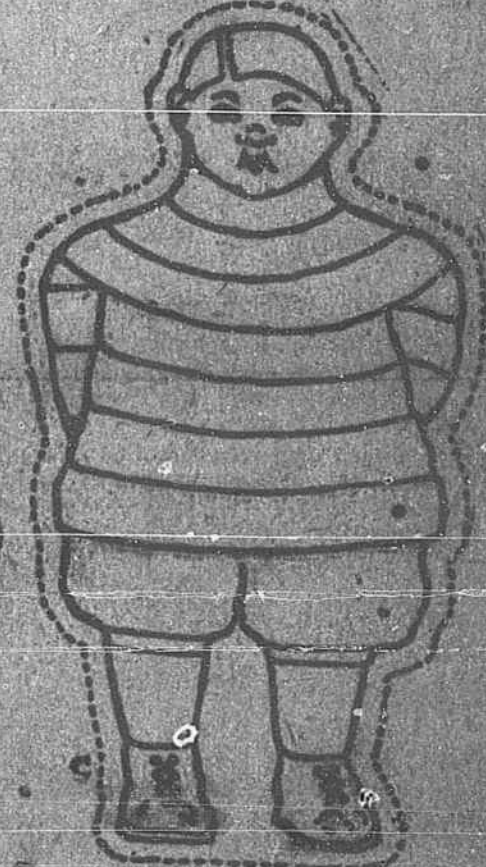
