NOTICE.

An Act to Regulate the operation of traction engines on or across public bridges si Anderson County; Section 17: Operation of traction engines across public bridges in Anderson county, regulated. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina; that from and after the passage of this act, say person, firm or corporation, using or causing to be used, any traction engine or en to be used, any traction engine or en-gines, on or across the bridges on the public highways in Anderson County, shall in crossing any of the said bridges, place upon the surface of said bridge pieces of timber not less than two inches thick and twelve inches wide, on which said timbers the said engines may ness and cross the said engines may pass and cross the said bridges. * * * * DAMAGES.

DAMAGES. Section 2.—Any person, frm or cor-poration who shall violate the provis-ions of Section 1 of this act, shall be liable to the said County, for all dam-ages done to any bridge therein. The above set was passed at the 1914 session of the General and will be strictly enforced.

If any passes shall wilfully destroy, injure, or in any manner hurt, dari-age, impair or obstruct any of the pub-ile high-space and part thereof, or any bridge, culvert, drain, diten, causeway, embankmens, wall, tolignte, tolihouse, or other erection belonging therete, at any part thereof, the per-son so offending shall, upon cenviction thereof, be imprisoned not more thin its months, or pay a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, or both, at the discretion of the court, and shall be further liable to pay all the expenses of repairing the same.
