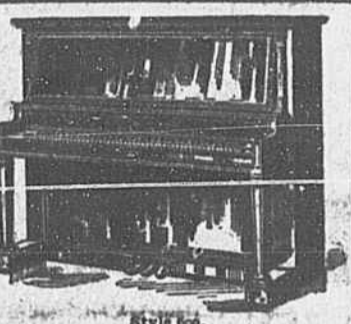

NOTICE

An Act to Regulate the operation of traction engines on or across public bridges in Anderson County.

Section 1. Operation of traction engines across public bridges in Anderson county, regulated. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina; that from and after the passage of this act, any person, firm or corporation, using or causing to be used, any traction engine or engines, on or across the bridges on the public highways in Anderson County, shall in crossing any of the said bridges, place upon the surface of said bridge pieces of timber not less than two inches thick and twelve inches wide, on which said timbers the said engines may pass and cross the said bridges.

DAMAGES.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 of this act, shall be liable to the said County, for all damages done to any bridge therein.

The above act was passed at the 1914 session of the General and will be strictly enforced.

PENALTY FOR DAMAGING ROADS. If any person shall wilfully destroy, injure, or in any manner hurt, damage, impair or obstruct any of the public highways or any part thereof, or any bridge, culvert, drain, ditch, causeway, embankment, wall, tollgate, tollhouse, or other erection belonging thereto, or any part thereof, the person so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, be imprisoned not more than six months, or pay a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, or both, at the discretion of the court, and shall be further liable to pay all the expenses of repairing the same.
