A CLEVELAND SHOW WINDOW. Of all the different forms of advertising one approaches the Daily newspaper which goes into the homes, for there is where the want first occurs, and there is where the filling of that want is first thought of, and discussed, and in many cases there the decision is reached to buy and many times the home is where the very store is selected in which to purchase the article wanted—hence the newspaper which carries the merchant's message into the home is the best medium of publicity today.

The window of Walter H.
