Butter, the principal of the school, has charge of the sewing department and Henry Sutton supervises the carpenter shop. The work done by the pupils in both departments is very creditable. Vewell Williams has charge of the domestic science department and ft is understood that she s doing a good work in training excellent cooks.

This school hes grown in the past 15 or 20 years from a two-teacher school to one employing seven teachers. There are nine grades and George states that he is making an effort to have a tenth grade and an extra teacher added next year. Particular attention is being paid to training hands as well as heads, and this is as it should be. That kind of education will do the negro race, as a whole, a great deal more good than an attempt to give them training that will be of no practical benefit in later
