Vewell Williams has charge of the domestic science department and it is understood that she is doing a good work in training excellent cooks.

This school has grown in the past 15 or 20 years from a two-teacher school to one employing seven teachers. There are nine grades and George states that he is making an effort to have a tenth grade and an extra teacher added next year. Particular attention is being paid to training hands as well as heads, and this is as it should be. That kind of education will do the negro race, as a whole, a great deal more good than an attempt to give them training that will be of no practical benefit in later years.

George also states that he and Sutton will be glad to repair furniture, make porch swings, etc., this summer for those in need of this class of work.
