Mr. and Mrs. Levi Creech and little daughter, of the Olar section, were in the city Wednesday of this week.

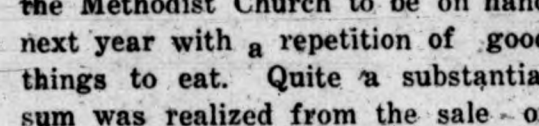
Mr. Moses Green and son, of Sumter, spent the week-end with the former's daughter, Mrs. Solomon Blatt.
