THE ELECTRIC PLANT OF NICARAUGA. -A plant, supposed to be new, has been found in Nicarauga, which, if what is said of it be true, is a great vegetable curiosity. It has been named "Phytolacca Electrica." It is said to possess very pronounced electro-magnetic properties. The hand is sensibly benumbed upon touching the shrub, and the magnetic influence is felt at a distance of seven or eight feet. The magnetic needle is sensibly perturbated, becoming more and more so until it reaches the centre of the shrub, when the disturbance is transformed into a very rapid gyra-tory movement.
