## MARS．

Polnts About His Moon II．II．Parkhurst in the Neos Yorle Herald．
There are some curious circum ntances with reference to the newly
disoovered satellites of Mars which discovered satellites of Mars which
have not yet been published，arising from the shortness of their periods of revolution．Tho outer satellite revolves in thirty hours and four－ teen minutes．While Mars is re－ volving upon its axis once，this moon goes about three fourths of
the way round，so that if it rose with the sun this morning，to－mor－ row morning it would have only hereacd the meridian，and would not set until the next moming，when it would remain for two days below
the horizon；so that it would bo the horizon；so that it would be
four days less forty two minutes， before the satellite would rise again． But it goes through all its phases－ new moon，full moon，last quarter
and new moon again－overy thirty－ two hours，or threo times during one diurnal revolution．Rising with ing at 6 oclock，it would be full moon at $10, \mathrm{p}$ ． m ．，before it reached the meridian；new moon again at 2，p．m．，to－morrow，soon after pass－
ing the meridian，and full moon again when it set at 6 o＇clock tho next morning．
The inner satellite revolves in seven hours thirty－eight minutes， equivalent to eight hours and six
