PRESIDENT AND PEOPLE.

Special Message of McKinley to the National Government, Referring to the Condition and Needs of the Devastated Region.

The President sent the following message to the Senate and House of Representatives last week:

Information which has recently come to me from the Governors of Arkansas, Mississippi and Louisiana and from prominent citizens of these States and Tennessee, warrants the conclusion that widespread distress, involving the destruction of a large amount of property and loss of human life, has resulted from the floods which have submerged that section of the country.

It has, therefore, seemed to me that the representatives of the people should be promptly informed of the nature and extent of the suffering and the needs of these stricken people, and I have communicated these facts in the hope and belief that the legislative branch of the government will promptly re-enforce the work of the local authorities in the States named.

Under such circumstances, the citizens of these States look for co-operation and support of the national government in relieving the pressing cases of destitution for food, clothing and shelter which are beyond the reach of local efforts.

Precedents are not wanting that in such emergencies as this Congress has taken prompt, generous and intelligent action, involving the expenditure of considerable sums of money with satisfactory results.

The citizens' relief committee of Memphis which has taken prompt action has already cared for from 6,000 to 7,000 refugees from the flooded districts, and

they are still arriving in that city in large numbers daily. Supplies and provisions have been sent to the various points in Arkansas and Mississippi by this committee; but the utmost that can be done by these efforts is to partly relieve the most acute cases of suffering. No action has yet been taken for the great majority of the inhabitants living in the interior whose condition has already been described.

It has, therefore, seemed to me that the representatives of the people should be promptly informed of the nature and extent of the suffering and the needs of these stricken people, and I have communicated these facts in the hope and belief that the legislative branch of the government will promptly re-enforce the work of the local authorities in the States named.
