NARROW ESCAPE FROM DEATH.

Harrowing Experience of Three Women in Charleston.

Charleston, July 8.—Three women, Mrs. W. W. Wise, Mrs. Amelia Daily and Miss Mary Daily had a narrow escape from being burnt to death or injured by jumping from the windows of their house in a fire which partially destroyed their home on King street between 1 and 2 o'clock this morning. The police officer on that beat was the first to discover the fire and pulled the box. He hammered on the door to awaken the ladies but it was not until some time afterwards that they appeared at the windows enveloped in smoke and were about to jump to the pavement below when the spectators called to them not to do so. The firemen were soon on the scene and the women were rescued without hurt save to their nerves, after the severe strain through which they had passed. The damage to the house was only about \$500. The dispensary, which was on the first floor, was not damaged. The cause of the fire is not known.

Some excitement was caused about the county building and on Broad street today by Lawyer Matthews chasing a colored lawyer named Twine and attempting to beat him with an umbrella. It appears that the two lawyers were on opposite sides at the hearing of a small case in the judicial magistrate's court, when the colored lawyer told his opponent that he was a liar, but not in so many words. Mr. Matthews seized his umbrella and made at Twine, who fled out of the building and down the street, with the white man close behind him. The colored lawyer was too fast a runner for his white adversary and he finally outdistanced him.

THE DEADLY GRADE CROSSING.

Cincinnati, Ohio, July 9.—A west-bound train on the Pennsylvania Road struck a wagon containing nine people at a crossing eight miles east of this city to-night, killing four, fatally injuring three and seriously injuring two of the occupants of the wagon. Robert Copenhagen, with his wife and two children, aged 8 and 2 years respectively, were going from Red Comb Junction to Masonville. A daughter of a neighbor and four of their boarders, William Booth, Charles Johns, William Poole and another man, whose name was not learned, accompanied them. They did not observe the train, which was coming at a high speed. When the engineer saw them he blew his whistle, but it was too late to stop the train. The mules, on hearing the whistle, stopped and could not be moved. The animals were across the track and escaped unhurt, while the wagon was wrecked and all the occupants either killed or injured.
